IT'S ESSENTIAL

- GOD INVITES US TO BRING OUR BURDENS AND NEEDS TO HIM IN PRAYER. "Come to Me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28 NLT).
- ♦ GOD RESPONDS TO THE PRAYERS OF HIS PEOPLE. "The earnest prayer of a

righteous person has great power and wonderful results" (James 5:16b NLT).

- GOD IMPARTS WISDOM AND UNDERSTANDING THROUGH PRAYER. "If you need wisdom—if you want to know what God wants you to do—ask Him, and He will gladly tell you. He will not resent your asking" (James 1:5 NLT).
- GOD EXERCISES HIS AUTHORITY AND ABILITY TO DO THE IMPOSSIBLE THROUGH THE PRAYERS OF HIS PEOPLE. "If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer" (Matthew 21:22 NLT).
- GOD EXTENDS HIS POWER TO US THROUGH PRAYER SO THAT WE MAY RESIST <u>TEMPTATION</u>. "Keep alert and pray. Otherwise temptation will overpower you. For though the spirit is willing enough the body is weak!" (Matthew 26:41 NLT)
